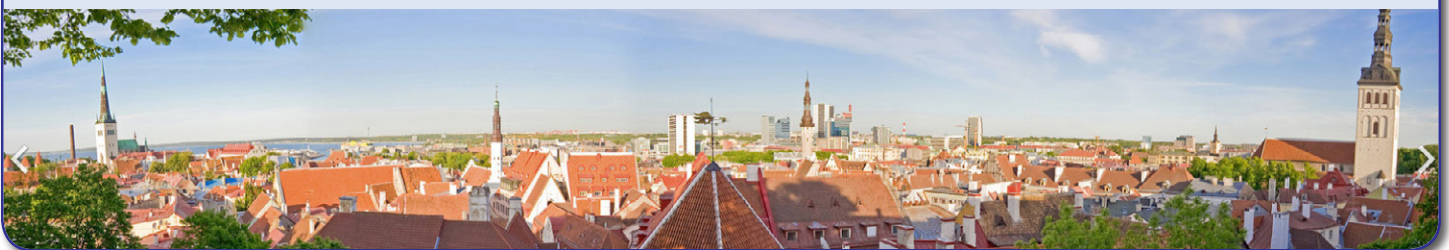


nutrition, physiology, livestock farming systems as well as cattle, horse, pig, sheep, and goat production and their allied industries.
